Summer Checklist

Important items you need to complete in July.



ACADEMIC

- If you haven't already, register for and take proficiency exams as soon as possible.
- Complete the Office of Field Education Survey, sent via email in mid-July
- Connect with Disability Resources if seeking academic accommodations.
- Submit a final, official transcript if it hasn't been submitted previously.

FINANCIAL

- Domestic Students:** If you've been awarded federal financial aid, submit your signed Financial Aid Letter by July 8. If you're anticipating a loan refund, consider adding direct deposit in your student account.

PREPARING FOR ARRIVAL

- Upload your COVID-19 vaccine documentation to the student health portal by July 15, or schedule your vaccine as soon as possible.
- International Students:** Notify the Admissions Office of your visa status and travel plans.
- Submit a photo for your student ID.
- Register for New Student Orientation; instructions will be sent in late-July.
- Consider purchasing a parking pass; info will be provided in mid-July.
- Register for your U-Pass to access St. Louis Metro Transit, available in late-July.
- Explore housing resources and plan your move to St. Louis.
- Check your @wustl email account often. Format your email signature.
