Change to Brown School Professional Development Parking Policy

Please be advised that for workshops, institutes and activities occurring after September 1, 2017, the registration fee no longer includes the cost of parking on campus.

Why is this change occurring?

While the costs of providing programming to our community continue to climb, the Brown School has not raised our Professional Development program fees in nearly 20 years. The cost of visitor parking on campus has recently increased; we could not sustain our current fee structure while still covering the cost of parking. Rather than increase our registration fees, we determined it would serve our participants better not to make this choice for you but to provide a range of options so that each individual can select the transportation option that best suits their unique situation.

What options do I have?

- *Pay for visitor parking on campus.* There will be visitor parking available in each of the 3 Danforth Campus garages, including the DUC garage (level 1) which is the closest one to the Brown School. The cost to park is up to \$9 per day.
- *MetroLink.* The Brown School is located just a few hundred feet from the Skinker MetroLink station. [Click here to learn more about Metro's service and routes.](#)
- *Bike or walk.* If you live or work near campus, biking or walking may be convenient. There are ample racks to secure your bike near the school.
- *Uber or taxi.* Increasingly, we hear that campus visitors are using Uber to meet their transportation needs.

What if I am disabled?

- There are disabled spaces near the Brown School. To access them, you must have both a state-issued disabled parking tag and an additional Washington University tag that we can mail you. To request this or any other accommodation, we need you to contact our office at least 7 days in advance of your first class meeting.
- If you do not have a state-issued disabled parking tag or there are less than 7 days until your first class meeting, please park in visitor parking (at your expense). When you arrive on campus, you can request a golf cart to take you from your car to the program location by calling 314-935-3648. This service is available 8:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.
