- MSW degree or a Master's degree in a related field (for concentration-level students only)
- At least two years post degree experience
- A minimum of one year of employment in an agency that has or is willing to establish a formal affiliation between the agency and the Brown School
- Availability and willingness to attend the required training
- Demonstration of high standards of professional values and ethics
- Submission of affiliation materials to the MSW Field Site Coordinator
